

# Air Corps Plucks Thompson From Trojan Cinder Squad

Wilbur (Moose) Thompson, husky Trojan weightman, revealed yesterday that he would be leaving S.C. sometime during the next 10 days for the Army Air Corps and then made sure that he would be missed by putting the shot 48ft. 2in. for one of the best marks turned in by Troy's cinder stars in an informal meet yesterday morning on Bovard Field.
