

S.C. Trackman in Time Trials

Running strictly under wraps, Coach Dean Cromwell's S.C. tracksters went through their time trials yesterday for the coming handicap meet with Occidental next Saturday.

Earl Audet, gigantic transfer from Georgetown, turned in the day's best mark, heaving the shot out 50ft. 11½in. Audet has been practicing with a 19-pound shot and found his timing slightly off.

Ray Johnson and Cliff Bourland breasted the tape together in a 51.1s. quarter, Searles Tally soared over the high jump bar at 6ft. 2½in. and Bill Mayo won a 10.2s. century.

Warren Smith, who is going to double duty in the half mile and mile this season, toured the four laps in 4m. 53.8s., running the last quarter in 61 seconds.
