

# Freshman Flash Runs Low Sticks in 14.8s for Bovard Field Mark

A new Trojan track star was born yesterday as Al Lawrence, in his first appearance in the Cardinal and Gold uniform, shattered the Bovard Field 140-yard low hurdle record with a sizzling 14.8s. performance.

The occasion was the first cinder meeting coaches Dean Crom- meeting of Coaches Dean Crom- which found the Troy veteran's freshman squad compiling a 55-48 victory over Eagle Rock High School.

Lawrence dashed off his spectacular time in a special race, the Dean choosing to work out the ex-Glendale flash and Roland Sink, sturdy little miler from South Pasadena, against his varsity athletes. Both are freshmen. The old mark was established by Earl Vickery in 1938 at 15s. flat.

Sink reeled off a fine 3m. 12.5s. 1320-yard run, an indication he will trim his best previous mile effort, 4m. 21.4s., considerably this season.

## Crum Nabs Jumps

As for the official meet contestants, honors were divided among Gordon Stewart and Guy Hogue of the Eagles and George Crum of the Trobables, each nabbing two firsts.

Stewart took both hurdles, winning the highs in 16.1s., and the 140-yard lows in 16.3s. Hogue annexed the 100 in 10.3s. and the furlong in 23s., while Crum, a fine prospect from Wilson High, was tops in the high jump at 5ft. 5in. and broad jump, 22ft. ½in.
