

# Lawrence Leads S.C. to 83-48 Win Over Bears

BERKELEY, May 6. (U.P.)—

The University of Southern California track team defeated University of California, 83 to 48, today in their traditional track and field meet held at Edwards Stadium.

Taking 12 first places in the 15 track and field events, the Trojans rolled to an easy victory over the Bears with Freshman Al Lawrence leading the S.C. squad with 18 points.

## Lawrence Stars

Lawrence won the pole vault at 13ft., copped the 220 low hurdles in 23.9s. and the 120 highs in 14.8s. and placed second in the broad jump for the day's outstanding individual performance.

Miler Roland Sink, another Trojan freshman star, took his specialty with ease over Mac Elliott and Don Walker of California. His time was 4m. 23.2s. Sink came back to win the two-mile run in 9m. 54.7s., an S.C. freshman record.

In the 880-yard run Paul Iacono, ace Trojan half-miler, won by 75 yards over Jim Jordan and Lee Huntington of California in 1m. 56.8s.

Leslie Howe of California, a

transfer from the University of Missouri, won the high jump with a leap of 6ft. 3in.

Earl Audet, S.C., National A.A.U. shot-put champion in 1943, in winning the shot-put with a toss of 51ft. 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ in., was just an eighth of an inch off the meet record.
