

Troy Spikemen Edge Hoover

Glendale Hoovers' up-and-coming track and field squad forced Dean Cromwell's S.C. novice spikemen to the limit yesterday but bowed in the final count, 52 $\frac{3}{4}$ to 50 $\frac{1}{4}$, in a practice meet.

Hoover had the meet well in hand until the last three events but the Trojans came through with first and seconds in both pole vault and the high jump to nip the prep stars. The winners:
