

Track Teams Work Out in Prep Meet

Raising the curtain for the 1945 Southland track season, the Trojan Novices, Glendale High School and City College met in a triangular meet at Bovard Field yesterday.

Although no official tally was recorded on the meet, sideline bystanders posted an unofficial score which gave the Troymen 49, Glendale 44½ and City College 35½.

The host club hit the winning circle five times and featured their ace miler, Arno Elias, who sprinted to an easy victory in the 440 in the time of 52.9s. Elias did not start in the mile.

Outstanding was Sylvester Bell of City College, who was the only one to score two triumphs. He annexed the high jump with a 6-foot leap and turned the trick in the broad jump at 22ft. 5in.

Glendale High's Bob Belnap sparkled for the prepsters when he broke the tape in the 100 in 10.2s. Following are winners:
