

Five Records Smashed in Pasadena Trackfest

The 1945 track and field season was climaxed before 4500 Rose Bowl fans last night as the cream of the Southern California cinder crop competed in the fourth annual Pasadena Games.

Five of the twenty-eight events on the program resulted in new meet records and respective team champions were Caltech in the open division and Jefferson High School in the prep class. More than 600 athletes participated in the day-long program which started in the afternoon. The meet marks that went by the boards were the open shot-put, bettered by Earl Audet of S.C. when he tossed the ball 52ft. 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ in.; Glenn Wills, 100-yard dash, 9.7s.; George Long, servicemen's 100, 10s.; and Rudy de la Torre, high school 440, 51.3s.; Ray Kring, open pole vault, 13ft. 3in.

Just as expected, the prep mile and low hurdle races stole the show.
