

Trojans Easily Capture San Diego Spike Relays

SAN DIEGO, March 30. —

Braving the storm that swept virtually the entire Southland, San Diego State College just did manage to run off its Aztec relays here today before the rains came.

Much to the surprise of no one, Coach Dean Cromwell's S.C. Trojans walked off with open division honors with 53 points,

with U.C.L.A. nabbing second with 25 and the Los Angeles Athletic Club third at 20½. Santa Monica City College eked out a one-point triumph over Pepperdine in the college class, 32-31, while Compton and Santa Barbara tied for third at 23 apiece. San Diego High scored 60 points to win the high school competition.

Five Early Marks

Competing on the well-banked Balboa Stadium track, the athletes turned in some fine early marks but the precipitation in the latter stages hampered them considerably. Only event halted, however, was the pole vault, in which Bob Hart and Tex Winter of S.C. were the lone survivors when it was called at 12ft. 6in. The latter, a former Compton J.C. and Oregon State 14-foot vaulter, just decided today to use up the one year of eligibility he has left instead of waiting until 1947.

The Trojans amassed the bulk of their points with solid one, two, in the pole vault, high jump and two-mile relay plus an easy win in the mile-long baton chase and a second in the half-mile affair.

The latter event provided the day's closest windup when S.C.'s Mel Patton made up some 15 yards on the San Diego Naval Training Center and U.C.L.A. runners to wind up in a blanket

anish. Bruin Craig Dixon managed to stick his chest out the farthest and Paton, on the extreme outside, was second. The clocking was 1m. 32s.

Little Roland Sink didn't have to roll very fast in anchoring the Trojan two-mile team but even then was clocked in 1m. 58.2s. His teammates were Perry Brown, Tom Tackett and Wally Wilson. The time was 8m. 5.4s.

Bucking a moderate wind, the sprint times were comparatively slow. Bill Smythe edged Trojan George Beaman in the open century at 10.2s. while Willie Steele of the host school took the college 100 in 10.3s.

Bangert Wins Shotput

Bill Bangert, Purdue's national collegiate shot and discus champion, opened the show by singing the national anthem and immediately after annexed the shot-put at 51ft. 1in. He went unplaced in the platter-heaving contest when he fouled on all but one spin. Al Hershey of L.A.A.C. trailed him in the shot at 50ft. 6in. and won the discus with a net 155ft. 1in. effort.

Best of the other marks were Bobby Peoples' 196ft. 3in. heave in the javelin; Ray Kring, College of Pacific, 13ft. 3 1/2 in. in the college pole vault, and the 6ft. 4in. leaps of Bill Wakefield and Tom Follis of S.C. and Ed Luce, Stanford's one-man team competing unattached. They deadlocked for the blue ribbon.
