

Observers Cry 'Foul' Against S.C. in Relay

While speculation continues in S.C.'s squeaky half-point victory over the San Francisco Olympic Club in the West Coast Relays at Fresno Saturday night, athletes from Southland schools arrived back in town yesterday and started preparations for the Coliseum invitational meet Saturday at the Coliseum.

Most of the discussion after the meet was centered on the Trojans' triumph over U.C.L.A. in the four-man 880-yard relay. Al Lawrence of S.C. hit the tape a yard ahead of Bruin Craig Dixon, but most observers maintained that Jim O'Reilly, in passing the baton to second man George Beaman, passed the restraining line without the offi-

cial calling the foul. If the Trojans had been disqualified in this race the San Francisco Olympic Club would have won the meet with 37 1/2 points while the Bruins would have wound up second at 35 and the Trojans third with 28 1/2. As the official score was rendered, however, S.C. tallied 38 1/2 digits to nip the Winged O Flyers.

Most significant factors of the meet were the field event marks, which showed that five out of the six winning marks exceeded those made in the Penn and Drake relays.

Five Fresno Bests

A compilation shows that in 13 common events the Fresno competition contributed five of the top marks, Penn had four best efforts and equaled another while the Drake competitors surpassed competition in two events and deadlocked in a third.

Best of the Fresno efforts were 14.4s. in the 120-yard high hurdles by Craig Dixon of U.C.L.A.; 152ft. 10in. by Pete Zagar in the discus; 53ft. 2in. in the shotput by S.C.'s Wilbur Thompson; 14ft. in the pole vault by Irving Moore of the Olympic Club, and 25ft. 5/8in. in the broad jump by Willie Steele, San Diego State.

Marks heading the list at Penn were 9.8s. in the 100, 41.5s. for the 440 relay, 3m. 18.4s. in the mile baton chase, 7m. 57.1s. in the two-mile event and 6ft. 4in. which was good enough for a high jump tie. Drake's top events were 880 relay in which they ran 1m. 28.1s.; distance medley, 10m. 24s., and the high jump deadlock of 6ft. 4in.
