

CRAMPS PLAGUE TROY AS BEARS LOSE MEET

BERKELEY, May 11. (AP)—The favored University of Southern California track team scored a 75½ to 55½ victory over California at Edwards Field today.

The Trojans were expected to run up 100 points or better against the poorly rated California team, but Hurdler and Broad Jumper Al Lawrence of Southern California was withheld from any competition by Coach Dean Cromwell and Miler Roland Sink, U.S.N.R., and Sprinter Mel Patton, hit by cramps, competed in only one event each.

Sink won the mile in 4m. 17.3s. He appeared well on the way to a new meet record as he entered the final lap, having run the first lap in 62 seconds, the half in 2m. .07s. and three-quarters in 3m. 12s., but when he tried to run the final lap in approximately 60 seconds to break the record of 4m. 13.7s., he developed muscle cramps and finished slow.

Patton, after winning the 100-yard dash in 10 flat, suffered a muscle cramp in the first 50 yards of the 220 and dropped out of the race.
