

Olympic Club Captures A.A.U. Spikefest Honors

BERKELEY, June 14. (AP)—Taking eight firsts and tying for another event, the San Francisco Olympic Club team piled up 67 points today to win the 1947 Pacific Association (A.A.U.) track and field championship.

San Jose State College took second with 50, while University of California athletes, performing unattached, accumulated 26½.

Steers Competes

Among the candidates for next year's Olympic Games team competing today was Les Steers of Portland, Or., who holds the world's high jump record of 6ft. 11in. He tied with Chuck Hangar of California at 6ft. 5in. for first place here.

Al Lawrence of S.C., one of the few Southern Californians in the meet, took the 220-yard low hurdles in 23.9s. Another Trojan,

Jim Slosson, was second in the 440-yard run, won by Hoff of Stanford in 49s.
