

# Cromwell Juggles His Men for Bengal Meet

Entries for tomorrow's Trojan-Occidental track meet were revealed last night by Coaches Dean Cromwell of S.C. and Payton Jordon of the home team Bengals.

The veteran Trojan coach, whose powerhouse outfit will be making its season debut, has switched a number of his athletes from their normal specialties, but Jordon's Oxy athletes will be working at their regular events for the most part.

Chief changes for the Trojans:

1—Ron Frazier, low hurdles specialist, will concentrate on the two sprints to make up for idle Mel Patton.

2—Roland Sink, miler, and Robert Chambers, 880 star, will trade about. Sink wants to build up his speed and Chambers is working on stamina. Sink and Chambers will also run on the relay team.

3—Wells DeLoach, star 440 man, will run in that event but will pass up the mile relay in order to also run in the 220.

4—Dick Attlesey, star high hurdler, will not run over the barricades, but is a probable member of the 440 relay team.

Jordon said that his star low hurdler, Ron Frieze, will also run the 100 and on the sprint relay foresome. A leg injury will keep Oxy's top javelin thrower, Mike Coster, out of action.
