

Patton Surprise Starter as Troy Trackmen Cop

TEMPE, Ariz., March 6—Mel Patton unexpectedly returned to competition today and ran a smooth 220 dash in 21.9s. as the University of Southern California track team powered to an 83-48 dual meet win over Arizona State.

Scheduled to make only an exhibition appearance, Patton felt so good under the warm sun that he entered the regular furlong dash and won by seven yards over Teammate George Beaman. With Patton out of the century, Beaman had won the short dash in 10s. flat.

Biggest upset of the day was the high hurdles victory of Ed Schnell of the Trojans over the aging Joe Batiste of State in 15s. flat. Schnell pulled away from the former national champion after they had raced even over the final barrier.

Chambers Impresses

Big Bob Chambers of the Trojans impressed with an expected triumph in the half mile in 1m. 57.5s., only a few strides ahead of Teammate John Cherry, timed in 1m. 58.9s.

The Trojans were short-handed because of a reduced traveling squad and had High-Jumper Tom Follis in the javelin, Shot-putter Bill Bayless in the high jump and Discus-Thrower Ed Dittenbir in the broad jump.

Bayless became so occupied with the high jump, in which he placed third by hoisting his 220-pound frame over 6ft., that he yielded first place in the shot-put to his fellow Trojan, Henry Springer.
