

# Chambers, Patton and Sink Star

Shuffling his aces like a cardshark, cagey Dean Cromwell teamed up with his SC Trojan tracksters to hand Ducky Drake and his upstart UCLA Bruin gang a crushing 81 1/6-to-49 5/6 setback in their annual dual meet at the Coliseum yesterday afternoon before 10,117 fans.

In the freshman meet, run concurrently with the varsity events, the Trobables won, 77-54.

The wily Dean made several strategic shifts in personnel and the lads came through to make him, as usual, unbeatable. It was the 15th straight year the Trojans raked in the pot.

## Troy Heroes

Leading the way were big Bob (Champ) Chambers, who completed the almost unheard-of double victory in the 440 and 880; Pell-Mel Patton, a meet record breaker in both sprints at 9.6s. and 20.6s., and Rolling Roland Sink, a romping winner in the mile and two-mile runs. His times were 4m. 20.1s. and 9m. 51.7s.

Cromwell tipped his hand right at the start. Instead of going for a sweep in the mile with Sink, Carmen Bova and Art Nash, he saved Nash for a better bet in the two-mile. The move paid off. Sink and Bova easily scored a one-two in the four-lapper and Nash came back to nip Uclan John Pattee after a hectic last-lap duel for second in the two-mile behind Sink.

Running Chambers in the 440 appeared like an even bigger gamble. But instead it proved the day's most lucrative pay-off. Drake countered by entering Frank Fletcher, also his top half-miler. Chambers not only was a 3-yard winner in 48.8s., but Wells DeLoach held on gamely to nip Fletcher, who was boxed most of the way by a teammate, for the place spot.

## Chambers Comes Through

Then, aided by the added rest between events because of the freshman competition, Chambers finished with a tremendous rush to take the 880 by eight yards in 1m. 54.8s. Bruin Ralph Gold, who holds the Bruin half-mile record but has been running the mile this season, filled in for Fletcher but he barely managed to hold off Troy Sophomore Bob Pruitt for second.

The Bruin cause went according to Hoyle in the 100, 220, high hurdles, shot-put, javelin, discus and high jump. But just when the Westwooders were struggling off the floor little Ronnie Frazier

applied the clincher by tying "sure thing" Craig Dixon in the low hurdles. Frazier, a classy little guy who had been unable to get under 24s. this campaign, ran stride for stride with the lanky Bruin ace and simply refused to give ground. The time, against a 7 m.p.h. wind, was 23.2s.

After that the 50 mile relay squad, minus Chambers' services but anchored by Wells DeLoach's 48.2s. closing lap, nipped the Bruins by a foot to make the thumping that much more resounding. The time was 3m. 19.5s.

### Patton Flies

Individually, Patton's marks were the day's most remarkable. After bettering his own meet mark of 9.7s. in the century he reeled off the fleet furlong against a 7.3 m.p.h. wind. The clocking bettered the meet mark of 20.9s. set by Trojan Hubie Kerns in 1942.

Other fine performances were turned in by Shot-putters Jerry Shipkey of UCLA and Trojan Bill Bayless. Both were at their best, Shipkey winning out by an inch with a big push of 53ft. 5 1/2 in. It was a new meet and school record for the burly Bruin.

John Montgomery, Troy's smooth bamboo leaper, beautifully jackknifed over 14ft. 4 in. for the second time this season.

Highlights of the freshman meet were Brubabe Jeff Lawson's double victory over SC's pride, Norm Stocks, in the 440 and 220. The times were 50.1s. and 22.1s. Trobabe Frank Johnson cleared 13ft. 6 in. in the pole vault for a new meet record.
