

Swope Tosses Shot 50 Feet

Jess Swope, giant SC tackle, got off the best shot-put of his career yesterday in Trojan track trials at Rancho Cienega Stadium. Swope, who holds the school's freshman record, heaved one 50ft. to nip Bill Bayless by four inches.

John Bradley, All-America prep sprinter from Glendale Hoover, was clocked in 10.3s. and 22.3s. for the frosh, over a heavy track and into the wind.

Dick Attlesey, out last year with a broken arch, was timed in 13.2s. in the 120-yard low hurdles and 10.4s. in the century.

Fastest in the 70-yard highs was Don Halderman with 8.9s.

Wilfrid Bailie, Santa Ana JC transfer, toured a 1320 in 3m. 20s., with Don Cheery clocking a mile and one-half in 7m. 28s.

Many of SC's top tracksters did not enter the trials, including Al Lawrence, Bob Chambers, Bob Pruitt and Wally Wilson.
