performances on the part of distance runner Jim Newcomb and hurdler Dick Attlesey, both double winners.

Southern California piled up 62 1/5 points. Stanford chalked up 42 1/5.

## THE FINISH

Other teams finished this way:

California 35, Oregon 31 1/5, Washington State 13, Washington 12, Oregon State 11 1/5, UCLA 7 1/5, Idaho 6 and Montana 5.

Newcomb, a 19-year-old Indian youth from Portland, Ore., turned in the day's iron man job to receive the plaudits of some 10,000 fans. He won the mile run in 4 minutes 19 6/10 seconds and came back later to front a big field in the two mile grind, clocked in 9 minutes 25 2/10 seconds.

His Trojan teammate, Dick Attlesey, won the 120 and 220 yard hurdles. He raced over the high barriers in 14.3 seconds and took the low hurdles at 23.5 seconds, winning each event easily.

## GOOD HEAVE

The winners bucked strong head winds ranging up to more than 10 miles an hour during the meet.

Stanford's shotputter Otis Chandler won his event with his record-shattering toss of 57 feet, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches scored Friday.
