

Attlesey, Davis in Swift Races

Dick Attlesey and Jack Davis won a pair of American record special distance hurdle events yesterday during the Southern California Conference meet at Oxy.

Attlesey took the 70-yard highs in 8.3s. Davis, who with SC Teammate Art Barnard was able to compete when the Stanford meet was rained out, took the 120-yard lows in 12.4s. No recognized American outdoor records existed in either event but local AAU Officials Larry Houston and Dr. Floyd Hanes will forward record applications to the National AAU.

Attlesey was a foot behind Davis in the lows with Bill Albans, Oxy ineligible, another foot back. Best previous time in the lows was 12.7s. by Craig Dixon at Alhambra in 1949.
