

Barrier Marks Toppled by Barnard, Davis

SAN DIEGO, March 24—Meet records fell in clusters as Southern California's track and field team rolled to a 103-28 victory over San Diego State College under balmy conditions here this afternoon.

Old stadium marks also were cheap as the Trojans scored first places in 13 events and registered midseason marks in a half dozen efforts.

Speedy Stickmen

Troy's hurdlers captured the fancy of railbirds by clambering to startling performances in both races.

Co-Capt. Art Barnard ran a sparkling 14.2s. flight in the highs to remove Jack Kaiser's 14.6s. record from both the meet and stadium books.

Sophomore Jack Davis equaled the stadium standard and fractured the meet mark by skimming the lows in 23.4s.

SC's Walter Jensen upset San Diego's Bobbie Smith by clearing a record-breaking 14ft. 3 7/16in. in the pole vault.

Seven meet and four stadium records were reupholstered by the Trojans during the afternoon.

San Diego's Jack Razzeto shared in one mark by tying with SC's Jack Barnes and Dick Brombach at 6ft. 5 1/4in. in the high jump.

Newcomb Doubles

The only double victory was scored by Troy's Jim (Chief) Newcomb, who jogged to comfortable winning margins in the mile and two-mile.

Parry O'Brien won the shot-put with one toss. He retired early to rest an aching back.

While making up seven yards on San Diego's Jack Ellis, SC's Sam Nicholson ran a 48s. lap to win the mile relay by an eyelash.
