

TROY GIVEN TOUGH CINDER WORKOUT

TEMPE, (Ariz.) April 7 — Southern California tracksters ran into surprising opposition tonight but flashed their national championship form to defeat tough Arizona State College 77 to 54, before 4500 enthusiastic fans in Goodwin Stadium.

The Sun Devils started off in surprising fashion winning the mile run and the 440 but the Trojans rallied in the later events to win the meet.

Nine Marks Fall

Nine meet records were broken and one standard tied as the two teams performed in mid-season fashion.

Brightest lights for Troy were hurdlers Art Bernard and Jack Davis who won the high and low hurdles, respectively. The Trojan duo took turns shattering meet marks in the two timber events. Bernard ran the highs in 14.1s. to break Dick Attlesey's mark of 14.2s. set last year. Davis skimmed over the low sticks in 23.1s.

Best for the Sun Devils was Bill Miller who set a meet mark in the javelin of 217ft. 5in. Miller also tied for second in the high jump at 6ft. $\frac{3}{4}$ in., the best jump of his life.

Newcomb Beaten

Troy's PCC Champ Jack Barnes won the high jump at 6ft. $5\frac{1}{4}$ in., also a new meet record.

Arizona State's Ben Jewell pulled the night's prize upset when he defeated Jim (Chief) Newcomb in the mile in 4m. 20.5s. Newcomb appeared to be in poor condition after being sick last week with the flu.

Sophomore Parry O'Brien continued his record-breaking ways in the shot-put, winning his pet event with a heave of 53ft. $5\frac{1}{2}$ in., a new meet record.

Donn Kinzle's Sun Devils won 8 first places to 7 for the Trojans but once again it was overwhelming depth that ground out the victory for SC.
