

O'Brien, Newcomb Pace SC Victory

Jim (the new) Newcomb and Parry O'Brien led the Trojans of Southern California to their 43rd straight track and field victory yesterday as SC slaughtered UCLA's Bruins, 94½ to 36½, at Westwood.

It was not only much the finest showing of the season for Jesse Mortensen's charges, it far surpassed even the most optimistic Trojan estimates of the outcome. And it gave the Bruins their first loss of the year.

Too Much Wind

The Westwood zephyrs were blowing right briskly yesterday, fast enough in fact to wipe out several meet record performances.

No wind gauge was available but Meet Referee Larry Houston ruled that the breeze, obviously in excess of the allowable 4.472 m.p.h., aided the runners and broad jumpers so much that a new meet standard in the long jump was disallowed as were record-equaling achievements in the 100 and high hurdles.

The only meet record to fall, legally, was in the shot, where O'Brien, the sophomore giant from Santa Monica, shoved the 16-pound ball 53ft. 5¼in., just a half inch better than Jerry Shipkey's 3-year-old standard.

O'Brien's most amazing achievement of the day came in the discus, however.

Parry, who had an all-time competitive best of 126ft. and hadn't placed in a single meet this year, tossed the discus 155ft. 6in. to win that event, one which the Bruins had been banking upon. He had some other long tosses to indicate he has found a new department of successful activity.

Chief Rolls

Newcomb was quite the show for SC on the track.

The Chief, who had finished last in the mile and hadn't even completed the two mile against Illinois and Michigan two weeks ago, showed his comeback is really gaining momentum, if it's not entirely here.

He scored an impressive mile victory in 4m. 17.6s., laying back for three laps and then uncorking a final leg in 58s. to beat Bruin Don Hagen by eight yards.

An hour and 20 minutes later he took the two mile in 9m. 37.9s.

Work Wins

UCLA scored its expected triumphs in the dashes, although Rod Richard was entered in the 440 trying to crack the SC duo of John Bradley and Sam Nicholson, failing in that attempt and getting only third. As a result Al Mejia of Troy took seconds in both sprints.

Bobby Work took the 100 by

two feet in 9.6s., which would have equaled Mel Patton's meet mark but for the official edict. It did, however, crack the UCLA school record of 9.7s. held by Work, Gordon Mollett and Hal Sinclair, and will be accepted as a Bruin mark.

George Brown, who had broad-jumped 25ft. 3¼in. for another disallowed meet record, took the 220 for UCLA in 21s.

Bradley's 440 time was 48.6s., his best.

In the frosh meet, held in conjunction with the varsity affair, Troy won 74½ to 54½. SC's Jim Lea took the 100 in 9.9s., the 220 in 21.1s. and low hurdles in 23.9s. Weightman Desmond Koch of Troy took shot, javelin, second in discus and third in low hurdles.
