

Trojan Star's 182ft. 5in. Breaks American Mark

SAN DIEGO, March 22 — Big Sim Iness bettered the American discus record by more than two feet this afternoon, hurling the platter 182ft. 5in. as the Trojans romped over San Diego State College on the wind-swept Aztec oval, 115-16.

The Trojan discus star had two other throws over 175 feet to highlight the meet along with a 24ft. 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. leap by SC Broad Jumper Frank Flores and a :49 flat quarter by John Bradley. With the wind blowing around 15 m.p.h. on his back, Norm Stocks stepped the 220 in :20.6.

Lone Aztec Win

Only in the javelin were the Aztecs able to register a first place with Gene Sieben having a two-foot edge on Trojan Dick Hammer at 186ft. 8in.

The record throw by Iness, which surpassed the 1946 mark of 180ft. 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. of ex-Minnesotan Bob Fitch, is also a new SC school record. The previous mark of 174ft. 1 13-64in. was set by Ken Carpenter in 1936.

Iness had one toss which landed directly in the broad jump pit and three others which flew beyond onto the running track. In addition to his top mark, one was measured at 175ft. 10in. with another just a few inches shorter.

Wind at Angle

The wind which blew on the backs of the sprinters and broad jumpers was at right angles to the discus tosses.

The national collegiate record, also surpassed by the big Tu-

lare star today, is 178ft. 11½in. by Fortune Gordien of Minnesota, who also is the world record holder at 186ft. 11in., a mark set in Finland.

Coach Mortensen's newcomers, notably Jim Lea, Bob Cuning and Al Sandusky, came through with fine performances. Lea pressed Bradley all the way in the quarter while Cuning took the century in :10 flat.
