

# SC Freshmen in Spike Win

A triple win by Jim (Triple) Decker was mainly responsible for the SC Frosh track team's 71  $\frac{2}{3}$ -59  $\frac{1}{3}$  victory over the Camp Pendleton Marines on the Trojan track yesterday.

After winning the 100 in 9.9 and taking the 220 around a turn in 22.2, Decker, SC's top tailback candidate for next fall churned down the track for the third time to win the 160-low hurdles in 17.3, thus tying the track record held by Olympian Jack Davis.
