

Jim Decker's 9.7 Ties SC Frosh Record

With Jim Decker again showing the way, SC's frosh tracksters scored their third straight triumph by blasting visiting L.A. City College, 75-47, yesterday.

Decker, who's slated to be the Trojans' No. 1 tailback next fall, roared the 100 in 9.7 with no aiding wind to equal Adrian Talley and Mel Patton's yearling mark.
