

Shelton's 6-9 $\frac{3}{4}$ Paces PCC Romp

ANN ARBOR, Mich., June 23 (AP)—The powerful Pacific Coast Conference track squad crushed the best in the Big Ten here today with an 82 1-6 to 49 5-6 victory in the 12th annual meeting between the two conferences.

Paced by a magnificent crew from the University of Southern California, which produced six firsts and 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ points for the PCC cause, the West Coast athletes won 10 of the 16 events and tied in another to quench any last bit of optimism about Big Ten chances.

Shelton Soars

Two meet records fell but the feat that attracted the most excitement was the high jumping of Ernie Shelton, SC sophomore. The Trojan flier cleared 6ft. 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. for a new SC record.

The crowd of about 6100 gasped as Shelton paused after clearing the winning height and ordered the bar up to 6ft. 11in. for a crack at Les Steers' world record. He couldn't quite maneuver this height, however.

Sim Iness, the giant Trojan Olympic discus champion, broke with ease the meet record set by Stanford's Bob Mathias in 1951. He whirled the platter 178ft. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. Mathias' mark was 173ft. 4in.

Davis Wins Hurdles

Iowa's Rich Ferguson left the field to post a 9:03.4 in the two-mile, erasing the former record, 9:09.6, set by Michigan's Don McEwen in 1950.

Jack Davis, SC's hurdling demon, was the only double winner in the meet, taking the highs in 13.8 and the lows in 23 flat to pace the PCC juggernaut that last week made a similar

conquest of the NCAA meet at Lincoln, Neb.

Parry O'Brien, the shot specialist from SC, won with ease with a relatively short throw of 55ft. 9in. and added more West Coast points by placing second to Iness in the discus with a heave of 169ft. 8in.

Richards Takes 220

Other points came from the PCC 440-yard relay team, Jim Lea's 440 victory in 48.1, Rod Richard's 220 race in 21.6, Dale Skartvedt's broad jump of 23ft. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. and the mile relay.

Willie Williams, Illinois' flashy dash man, edged UCLA's Rod Richards in a 9.5 100 and Stacey Siders, Illinois' fine half-miler, won his specialty over Lon Spurrier of California in 1:52 flat.

The pole vault ended in a deadlock between Jim S. Wright of Illinois and UCLA's Len Eilers at 13ft. 6in.
