

Trojan Track Stars Sizzle

Des Koch Paces 110½-20½ Dual Win Over Arizona

TUCSON, March 27—SC's mighty track and field forces gave an awesome display of power here this sunny afternoon, sweeping to victory in all but one event for a 110½-20½ dual meet triumph over the University of Arizona.

It took the best broad jump in the country for Arizona to register its lone victory. That feat was performed by Malachi Andrews, former Los Angeles Jordan High athlete, who soared 25ft. ¾in.

In the matter of "best performances" the versatile Trojans accounted for several of them.

Koch's Long Throw

Individual leader in this respect was the erstwhile footballer, Des Koch. He uncorked the best javelin toss of his life by 16 feet to win the javelin at 197ft. 4¾in. and upset his teammate, Doug Maljala, who threw the spear 186ft. 6¾in.

Then Koch got off the best shot effort of his career, 50ft. 4in., to capture a second behind Fred Edwards' 51ft. 9¾in. Koch's 169ft. 11¾in. triumph in the discus gave him 13 points, top individual performance of the afternoon.

Bugbee's 21 Flat

It was the best by two feet for Edwards, Trojan sophomore, in his shot victory.

SC sprinters sped to impressive performances in the century and furlong. Howard Bugbee chalked up a sizzling 21 flat around a turn, only four-tenths off Andy Stanfield's world record for a 220 around a curve.

Joe Graffio, who was second in 21.3, shaded Bugbee by inches in the 100. Both were clocked in 9.7.

Other Jump Marks

Other reflections of Trojan power were the 6ft. 8in. high jump by Ernie Shelton and the 13ft. 11¾in. by Sophomore Walt Levack in the pole vault.

Andrews' sparkling broad jump was bracketed by leaps of 24ft. 7¾in. and 24ft.
