

Graffio, Long Set Records in PCC Spike Preliminaries

SEATTLE, May 28 (AP)—Not even waiting for Saturday's main event, Southern California's Trojans cracked one Pacific Coast Conference record and Stanford broke another today in the qualifying trials of the annual track and field meet.

Joe Graffio of SC, after a rather poor start, came like a sudden burst of flame to win the 100-yard dash in 9.5. The old mark was a 9.6 and was shared by three men.

Leo Long of Stanford whipped the javelin more than a foot over the record and nearly 30 feet beyond his competition to win the spear preliminary on a toss of 232 feet 4½ inches. The old standard of 231 feet 1 inch was set by Bob Peoples of SC in 1941.

Bitter duels shaped up for tomorrow's finals in the high hurdles and shot-put. Gerry Wood of Stanford took the first heat of the 120-yard high sticks

in 14.4 and Willard Wright, SC, won the second in 14.5.

In the shot-put, John Stellern, California, hit 53 feet 1 inch and a teammate, Charles Butt, was only a half-inch back. Clyde Wetter, UCLA, and Des Koch, SC, both topped 50 feet.

Another outstanding effort in the prelims was a 24-foot 6¾-inch broad jump by Jon Arnett, SC. He was not far shy of the 25-foot record set in 1940 by Jackie Robinson, UCLA.
