

Ledesma Runs

9:22.6 Two Mile as SC Triumphs

Fernando Ledesma, Trojan two-miler, and an unattached high jumper, Barney Dyer, posted superlative marks in their specialties yesterday at the SC track where Troy rolled to an easy victory over the Los Angeles Athletic Club and San Diego State in a triangular meet.

Coach Jess Mortensen's Trojans scored 92½ points to LAAC's 54 and San Diego State's 14½.

Ledesma, an in-and-outer last year, looked like he was in good shape as he won the two mile in 9:22.6.

Sails Over 6-8

Dyer, former Utah high jumper, cleared 6ft. 8¾in. but his mark didn't count for points in the event.

It was a good outing for the Trojans in a meet which saw four SC-San Diego St. and two SC-LAAC meet records go by the boards. New marks were set in the mile, two mile, javelin, high jump and pole vault.

In the latter event Troy's Walt Levack cleared 14ft. 1in. for a new meet standard and then barely missed on two of his attempts at 14ft. 5in.

But, SC did suffer one embarrassment — and in the first running event of the day, the mile.

Hunt 'Clips' Wing

Aztec Jim Hunt made up ground on Troy's Sid Wing in the last quarter to score a two-foot victory in 4:17.1. Not only was this time a new meet record but also a San Diego St. school standard.

Double winners were SC's Howard Bugbee and the Club's Brayton Norton. Bugbee won the 100 in 9.9 and captured the 220 in 21.6 around a curve. Norton triumphed in both the javelin and broad jump and placed second in the furlong.

Troy's Ray Martin got off a 55ft. 3in. put, his best ever, but only after the competi-

tion had concluded. His official winning heave measured 53ft. 8in.
