

SC SPIKERS LOOK SHARP IN DEBUT

Strongest Bruin Cinder Team Wins Only One Event in Relay Carnival at Westwood

Southern California's track and field debut was a highly successful one yesterday at Westwood as the men from Troy won all but one event in a relay carnival with UCLA's team which is regarded as the strongest in the Bruins' history.

Jim Ball won the high hurdles for UCLA in 15 flat. Another Bruin, Ron Drummond, was the individual leader in the discus at 165ft. 3in. but in this as well as other field events, victory was a team affair based on aggregate figures, adding the marks achieved by the three entrants from each school. And the Trojan trio outdistanced the Bruins in the discus as in other field events.

No team score was kept in the meet.

Many New Marks

Since this was only the second renewal of this relay carnival, new meet records were set in seven of the 10 events.

In the distance medley relay, where the Bruins counted on Sophomore Bob Seaman to anchor a victory, the Trojans finished first with a creditable early season mark of 10:12.9 with the Bruins two seconds slower.

Seaman was timed in 4:15.9 for his anchor mile in which he made up 25 yards on SC's Sid Wing but he was still 10 yards behind at the tape. Trojan leg times were 48.7 for Mike Larrabee, 1:54.2 for Bill Taylor, 3:10.5 for Fernando Ledesma and 4:19.7 for Wing. Taylor's sparkling 880, equal to his best effort of the entire 1954 season, put the Trojans far in front.

Easy Victories

UCLA marks were 49 for Russ Ellis, 1:58.5 for George Holland and 3:11.3 for Bob Hunt.

SC also scored easy victories in the 440, 880, mile and two-mile relays. Larrabee's 48.3 anchor paced the four-man mile team and Phil White's 1:57.1 was fastest in the two-mile event.

Ray Martin scored his third victory over Bruin Don

Vick in four starts this spring by putting the shot 54ft. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. on his last trial. Vick did 53ft. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in.

Ernie Shelton and Floyd Jeter tied in the high jump at 6ft. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. for Troy and UCLA's Nick Dyer, a jaysee transfer, did just an inch less.
