The point total represented a new all-time high mark in the history of track competition between the two rivals, the previous record having been 105-26 for SC in 1930 and the same count for Calitornia in 1921. Yep, once upon a time the Bears could win track decisions from Troy.

Then three Trojans set individual meet records:

Ernie Shelton sceled 6ft. 10in. and narrowly missed at the world record level of 6ft. 11% in., dragging the bar off with his foot on his first tarsault, was the best in the world this year. His second and third shots at the record weren't as close as the first attempt.

Bid Wing, the juntor miler who is a transfer from Pullerton JC, produced a phenomenal five-and-a-half-acond improvement from his best previous performance and won in 4-11.7. This is the second best collegiste outdowr mile of the campaign (only Robby Seaman's 4-10.7 is us perfor). In a powerful and impressive performance the 24war-old Army yet had lap cicekings of 92.5, 240.7 and 306.6.

Fernando Ledesma, the junior distance ace from Compton, covered two miles in 9.11.1, which is the swift-

est winning eight-lapper by a collegian. Fernando covered the last lap in 65.2 in another impressive showing.
