## Shot Mark as

## SC Wins, 79-56

When Parry O'Brien was blotting out the shot-put record books and rewriting them in his own fashion while a collegian at SC a few years ago he set marks that seemed at the time outstanding and superlative.

Yet yesterday at the Coliseum two of O'Brien's records were shattered.

Ray Martin, who is 6 feet 4 inches tall and weighs 257 pounds, shoved the 16-pound weight 56ft.  $\frac{3}{4}$ in. as he and his Southern California teammates outscored Occidental, 79 $\frac{1}{2}$  to 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ .

### Loses Frosh Mark

This collapsed O'Brien's meet record of 55ft. 10in. set in 1953 when O'Brien was a senior. It also is better than O'Brien could achieve as a sophomore, which is Martin's present classification. Only twice in his soph year did Parry better 55ft. and his best, 55ft. 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ in. was in the National AAU meet in June.

O'Brien lost another record, also, for his SC-Oxy frosh meet mark of 51ft. 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ in. set in 1950 was wrecked by SC Yearling Dick Bronson with a 52ft. 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ in. try.

Of course the boys still have a way to go before O'Brien's world record of 60ft. 10in., set last year, is in any jeopardy.

Martin went to Van Nuys High and Valley JC. His prep best was 58ft. (12-pounder) and his jaysee mark was 53ft. 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ in. Bronson is from Crossmont High where he did 60ft. 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ in. (12-pounder)

### Shelton Sets Record

One other meet record fell in the varsity battle, Ernie Shelton scaling 6ft. 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ in. to raise the high jump standard set by Johnny Wilson in 1939. Ernie didn't have a miss until the bar was hoisted to 6ft. 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ in.

In the freshman meet, where the Trojans won, 68-63, by taking the relay, six meet marks were set and SC's Bob Lawson was the big hero, entering six events, winning three of them, and scoring 22 points. His efforts in the javelin and low hurdles accounted for records.

The varsity encounter went very close to form in the overall figuring although there were a number of events that surprised. SC took both relays where Oxy had been favored, but the Tigers countered with unexpected strength in such events as the low hurdles (finishing one-two with Dick Clarke and Larry Newquist where SC's Leon Clarke was the favorite), the broad jump (with a one-two punch) and the 100. In

the century SC's Howard Bugbee got only third behind Teammate Pat Coyle, the winner, and Oxy's Bill Carling.

The wind just about wrecked performances in the shorter events — Coyle's winning mark was 10.1, for instance, and Mike Larrabee's victorious 440 for SC just 49.6, a second over his best of the year. The wind came in strenuous gusts, from varying directions, and frequently lifted clouds of sawdust from the high jump and pole vault pits.

Later in the afternoon, however, it subsided somewhat and Larrabee supplied a 47.7 clocking for the victorious anchor lap in the mile relay where he made up four yards on Oxy's Eddie Shinn and beat him by six more.

### Score Duplicated

Just before that Fernando Ledesma had won the two-mile in a sparkling 9:20.6, his best of the year, and Trobabe Max Truex did 9:26.6 in the yearling division for one of the meet records.

The varsity score exactly matched the 1951 result, Oxy's point total representing the most scored against SC by a college foe in several years. Yesterday's crowd numbered 5342.
