

OLYMPIC CLUB, SC DOMINATE RELAYS

SANTA BARBARA, April 9—An Olympic Club quartet of John Nelson, Dave Pratt, Len Simpson and Lon Spurrier raced to a 7:29.5 two-mile relay time today to highlight the 17th annual Easter Relays at La Playa Stadium. Spurrier anchored in 1:49.8.

It was the second fastest winning two-mile relay clocking of all time, exceeded only by Fordham's 7:27.3 in the Coliseum Relays last year.

SC, as expected, dominated the open division, rolling up

44 points to capture the team title.

Trojan relay teams, freshman and varsity, racked up impressive times. The varsity captured the mile relay in 3:15.6 and distance medley in 10:07. The freshmen hung up a new national frosh record of 3:28.3 in the sprint medley and turned in a 3:18.3 clocking in the mile relay.

Other outstanding marks were Leo Long, Olympic Club, javelin (242ft. 8½in.); Ernie
