

# Rafer Johnson Paces Brubabes Spikers, 73-58

Rambling Rafer Johnson led the UCLA freshmen to their second dual track victory over the SC Trobables in 16 meetings yesterday as he scored 25 points in a 73-58 triumph at Westwood.

The Pan-American Games champ won three events, tied for first in two others and was second in his sixth event. Bob Lawson, the Trobables' versatile star, entered seven events and tallied 15 points.

Johnson was especially brilliant in his specialties, the hurdles. He took the highs in 14.5 for a new school and meet record and skimmed over the lows in 23.4 for a meet mark that also tied the Bruin yearling standard.

The ex-Kingsburg High star also tossed the discus 140ft. 6½in. to win the discus and tied with Lawson for top honors in the broad jump and high jump. Each long-leaped 23ft. 8¼in. and high-jumped 5ft. 10in.
