

Shelton Sets Jump Record

Ernie Shelton, former SC NCAA high jump champ, set a new decathlon world record of 6ft. 9in. yesterday in the All Comers Championship Decathlon Meet at Moor Field, Alhambra.

The previous record was 6ft. 7 $\frac{7}{8}$ in. by Bill Miller in 1951 at the national meet at Santa Barbara. The decathlon competition concludes today.

Wins Decathlon

Ernie Shelton, whose quest of the 7ft. high jump was thwarted all last track season, won the All Comers decathlon at Moor Field yesterday with a respectable total of 6460 points. His only opponent was his brother, Warren, who compiled 5624 for the 10 events.

Ernie's total would have placed third in this year's national AAU meet.

In a special shot-put event Don Vick of UCLA got off his best ever shot-put, 57ft. 5in. He also tossed the discus 156ft. 11½in. Hunter Cook won the javelin at 181ft. 5in.
