

Middie Runners Dominate Relays

San Diego Naval Training Center came up with the surprise packages of the annual AAU Relays yesterday at East Los Angeles JC Stadium as the middies captured three of the open-university division relays.

In two of the cases the sailor lads smashed meet records and in the other they equaled the best previous performance.

The meet, witnessed by 2000 fans, produced outstanding early season marks in all divisions with records collapsing in great numbers.

The open-university class produced the two baton marks by San Diego and another by Oxy and a new shot-put record when SC's big Ray Martin did 56ft. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ in., contrasted to Parry O'Brien's 3-year-old meet standard of 55ft. 4in. UCLA's Don Vick, at 56ft. 4in., also bettered the record and after the competition closed his 57ft.

The outstanding solo effort of the day was by Max Truex, the SC sophomore, in running off with the 5000 meters, an event held for the first time in this meet.

First Time

He was timed in 14:31.4, less than five seconds behind Wes Santee's American record and one of the better efforts in U.S. history. In 1952,

for instance, Truex's clocking would have placed him second in the U.S. Olympic trials for this distance of three miles plus 188 yards.

Max ran away from the pack after a few turns of the track and lapped nearly every one in the huge field.

SC had another fine individual performer, Jon Arnett missing the meet broad-jump record by only an eighth of an inch as he hit 24ft. 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ in.

Record Tied

The San Diego Navy sprinters, Fred Lucas, Ed Walter, Jack Davis and Milt Campbell, ran 41.7 in the 440 and 1:26.6 in the 880. The first tied a 14-year-old record and the 880 time wrecked a 19-year-old mark.

And the Navy half-milers, Steve and Paul Murphy, Willie Butler and Dick Foerster, led an assault on the two-

 mile record which saw four teams better the old mark. Foerster, the former Texas star, anchored in 1:53.5 but SC's Murry Coburn made up a few yards on him. Russ Ellis had a 1:52.5 leg and Bob Seaman 1:53 for UCLA.

Honors Divided

Oxy took the distance medley and record 10:17.3 time and the SC the mile relay.

College division relays honors were divided. Oxy frosh won four of five in the yearling class, and Mt. San Antonio and Compton each won five for five in the two divisions of jaysee competition.
