2-Mile Victory

TUCSON, March 17—SC's Max Truex ran the fastest outdoor two-mile of the season, 9:15.5, here today as the powerful SC track team routed Arizona, 105-26, before 6000 fans.

The Trojans, defending national champions, broke three stadium and seven meet records. Conditions were ideal with temperature at 80 deg.

Arizona managed to capture only one first place when Lynn Cornett high-jumped 6ft. 2½in. to beat a mediocre field.

SC's Sid Wing and Bob Volles broke their own meet records in the mile and javelin, respectively. Wing was clocked in 4:14.5 while Volles hurled the spear 204ft. 5in.

Dick Dorsey was the only double winner for Troy. The former Santa Monica City College star won the 100 in 9.8 but had to hustle to beat Junior Tate, an Arizona freshman, in a 21.5 220 around a curve.

Arnett Wins

Tate also extended SC's Jon Arnett in the broad jump. Arnett won at 24ft. 3 5-8in — one-eighth of an inch ahead of Tate.

World Record Holder Parry Obrien's stadium shot-put mark fell to Ray Martin. The husky Trojan junior set a new standard of 55ft. 2½in.
