

Truex Paces Troy's Victory

SC Relay Four Sparkles in Quadrangular Battle

Two bests of the 1956 track and field season, a dazzling two-mile by Max Truex and a well-balanced relay victory by SC, featured the Trojan triumph over three spike foes at the Coliseum yesterday.

Little Max — he's 5 feet 5 inches and weighs 130—covered two miles in 9:01.5, which would be a school record just about anywhere but SC. Fernando Ledesma last year set the national collegiate record at 8:57.7 as a Trojan junior.

10-Point Margin

The Trojan relay artists, with each man running a 48.2 or 48.3 lap, were timed in 3:13, also the best in the land to date.

Southern California scored its expected team victory, piling up 79 1/6 points to

69 1/6 for San Diego Naval Training Center, 12 1/4 for LAAC and 3 1/6 for San Diego State, in the quadrangular meet. An unofficial dual score between Trojans and Sailors saw SC win by 73% to 56%.

The meet produced its expected close battles in most of the flat races, except for the two-mile, and resulted in one startling upset when Jack Davis lost to Milt Campbell in the high hurdles. Both are on the Navy team.

Davis cracked into the first and third hurdles and by this time Campbell was five yards ahead of him. The former Trojan was picking up speed and ground, but the handicap was too much and he finished nearly two yards behind.

14.1 Victory

Campbell's time was 14.1 and Davis was given a 14.2. A week ago Davis did 13.7.

Dick Dorsey scored a double for Troy in the sprints, finishing like a bullet in the 100 after being even with Fred Lucas of the Navy at 80 yards. Lucas stayed out of the

220. Times were 9.9 and 21 flat.

In the closest race of the day SC's Mike Larrabee pulled out in the last 50 yards to edge Al Moore of the Navy and teammate Lanny Quigley in 48.6.

The 880 also produced a torrid finish, with Murray Coburn of Troy coming around a couple of runners on the last turn to easily outsprint Dick Foerster of Navy. The time was 1:53.1.

4:10.9 by Wing

Sid Wing ran the mile foes, including Navy's big threat, Paul Murphy, into the ground with a 59 second last lap and a 4:10.9 effort, one of the year's best by a collegian. Wes McLeod, a soph, held on well for 4:13.1, by far his best.

Truex's two mile, on even laps of just under 68 seconds, has been bettered by only five U.S. collegians in history. And he's just a soph!

The Trojan relay artists were, in order, Larrabee, Quigley, Chuck Kirkby and Coburn.
