Lea appeared to ease up when he hit the first tape and was timed in "only" 46.2 for the 440 yards, three yards longer. Close Miss Jack Davis again missed the world high hurdle rec ord by only a tenth second and other meet records were broken in the 400-meter hurdles, shot-put, 3000-meter steeplechase, 220 low hurdles and 5000-meter run.
