PALO ALTO, April 13 — Southern California turned loose the fury of its track and field power today to defeat Stanford, 72-59, in a dual meet.

The Trojans smashed five meet records and swept four events to spoil Stanford's hopes for its first track victory over SC since 1933.

The top iron-man performance, however, was by Stanford Cocaptain Frank Herrmann, who won three events—the 100 and 220-yard dashes and the broad jump.
