

# Trojans Hand Tribe Spikers 72-59 Defeat

PALO ALTO, April 13 — Southern California turned loose the fury of its track and field power today to defeat Stanford, 72-59, in a dual meet.

The Trojans smashed five meet records and swept four events to spoil Stanford's hopes for its first track victory over SC since 1933.

The top iron-man performance, however, was by Stanford Cocaptain Frank Herrmann, who won three events—the 100 and 220-yard dashes and the broad jump.

ner in the meet since Al Lawrence of SC turned the trick in 1946.

Trojan Sid Wing won the mile and the 880, setting meet records in both events. His time for the mile was 4:09.2 and for the half-mile, 1:51.2.

SC's Ron Morris recorded his all-time-best vault in winning the pole vault at 15ft. 2½ in., breaking another meet record.

### Fifth Best

Morris' vault was the fifth best in history behind World Record Holder Cornelius Warmerdam, the Rev. Bob Richards, Bob Gutowski and Don Bragg. He went over on his final try.

Trojan Max Truex set a meet record with a 9:06 clocking in the two-mile and Bob Voiles of SC tossed the javelin 237ft. 10in. for another.
