

Trojan Trackmen Triumph in Texas

DALLAS, Tex., April 18 (AP)—The University of Texas' 440-yard relay team and Abilene Christian's sprinter Bobby Morrow equaled world records tonight, but Southern California walked off with its fourth straight Dallas Invitational track and field meet title.

Trojan points were loaded with 1-2-3 finishes in the shot-put and discus. Ray Martin got off his best of the season in the iron ball with 54ft. 5½in., while Rink Babpa spun the platter 172ft. 8½in.

Other SC winners were Sid Wing in the mile, 4:15.2; Bob Voiles in the javelin, 224ft. 1¾in.; Ron Morris, pole vault, 14ft. 2in.; Max Truex, 2-mile, 9:14.2; Tom Anderson, 880 in 1:54.6, and the mile relay in 3:14.4.

The Texas sprint foursome

rocketed around the Dai-H stadium track's two turns in 40.2 seconds, while Morrow rode a strong southern breeze to a 9.3 century dash to lead the way as seven meet records were broken and two tied to the delight of a crowd of more than 10,000.

However, the vote for the meet's outstanding performer went 13-2 for Texas' Olympic Hurdler Eddie Southern, who ran the second leg of the sprint relay team and set meet records of 13.9 and 22.8 in the high and low hurdles. Morrow got the other two votes.

SC piled up 96 points to 71 for Texas, 33 for Abilene Christian, 17 for Southern Methodist and 12 for Texas A&M.
