

# SC, UCLA QUALIFY 13 FOR PCC MEET

EUGENE, Ore., May 17 (AP)—Southern California, ousted from the Pacific Coast Conference track championship last year after 15 consecutive titles, bounced back today to challenge UCLA for the crown.

UCLA, defending national champion, still was in the running, however, matching SC in qualifying men today for the final round of the annual conference meet tomorrow. Each qualified 13 men in the 10 events for which qualifying heats were held today.

Oregon took the lead in the fight for third place by qualifying 11. Stanford qualified eight, Washington seven, California five, Washington State four and Idaho one.
