

# Dumas, Babka Pace Trojan Win

TUCSON, Ariz., March 15 (U.P.)—Brilliant performances by High Jumper Charley Dumas and Discus Thrower Rink Babka highlighted an overwhelming University of Southern California victory in a season-opening track victory over Arizona and New Mexico today.

The Trojans are again strong contenders for national championship honors.

SC scored 115½ points to 32 for Arizona and New Mexico's 14½ and captured all but one first place.

### Dumas Does 6-10½

Dumas, world record holder with a jump of 7ft. ½in., cleared the bar today at 6ft. 10½in.

The 225-pound Babka threw the discus 183ft. 11in. for another top effort.

Bob Lawson of SC was high point man for the meet with 18, winning both hurdle events as well as the broad jump, and finishing second in the javelin. He skimmed over the high hurdles in 14.2, and took the low barriers in 23.9, while broad-jumping 24ft. 8in.

### Robertson Wins

Mal Robertson, who upheld Trojan distance honors in the absence of Max Truex, won the two-mile event in the creditable time of 9m. 14.6s.

The only non-Trojan victory came in the javelin, where John Quist of New Mexico threw the spear 198ft. 1in. for first place.
