

Cal Spikers Blasted by Troy, 91-39

BERKELEY, April 19 (AP)—SC's Max Truex bettered his own national collegiate two-mile record by running 8:54.8 today as SC overwhelmed California 91½ to 39½ in a dual track meet.

Truex, who stands only 5 feet 5 inches, and weighs 130 pounds, opened with a 67-second first lap, and steadily increased his speed and led second - place finisher Roger Price of California by 200 yards at the finish.

The old NCAA mark was 8:55 flat, set last year by Truex.

Meet Mark Goes

One other meet mark was bettered and three others were tied. Eight thousand saw the meet.

Rink Babka of SC broke the meet record in the discus with a toss of 181ft. 2½in., bettering his own record set in 1956 of 174ft. 2¾in.

SC's Bob Lawson, PCC champ in the high and low hurdles, was scratched just before the former event after apparently pulling a muscle in a warmup.

Don Bowden shattered the meet mile run record with a 4:05.8 clocking. Trojan Wes McLeod, who held the old 4:09.1 mark, finished last in a five-man field.

California's Willie White equaled the 23.2 meet record in the 220-yard low hurdles. White earlier won the 100 in 9.7.

Smith—47 Flat

SC Sophomore Ted Smith equaled the 440 meet record of 47 seconds set by Jim Lea of SC in 1954.

Charlie Dumas equaled the 120-yard high hurdles mark of 14.1 but it was disallowed because of a 6.1-mile-an-hour wind.

Dumas also won the high jump with a leap of 6ft. 8in.
