

Dumas Clears 6-11½ as Trojans Wallop Oxy Spikemen, 77 to 53

Form flew out the window yesterday as SC's spiked legions supplied most of the surprises for a 77 1/6 to 53 5/6 dual victory over host Occidental before some 6000 head-shaking fans. Oxy won the frosh meet, 69-62.

Surprise winners cropped up in six of the 15 varsity events but in four cases it was a Trojan nudging a Tiger and that was the story. Four dual meet records were set and another tied. Three Patterson Field marks topped.

Wins Hurdles First

Most significant performance was registered by Charley Dumas, who came through to win the high hurdles in 14.4, tying the meet mark, and then settled down for some serious high jumping.

He wound up with 6ft. 11½in., which broke every

record except his own world standard of 7ft. ¼in. It was a new meet, field, school and national collegiate mark. Ernie Shelton, Dumas' predecessor as king of the leapers, held the SC record at 6ft. 11¼in. and the collegiate high of 6ft. 11¼in.

Rink Babka spun the dis-

cus 184ft. 11½in. for meet and field marks and Maxie Truex lowered his own field best from 9:04.6 to 9:01.2.

Fast Mile

But the other two meet records came as surprises. Wes McLeod and Soph Bob Shankland finished in a virtual dead heat in a 4:07.8 mile but McLeod was credited with the victory. It was the second fastest winning mark made by a Trojan.

In the javelin Mike Page turned in his all-time best, 223ft. 9in., to upset Tigers Jon Jamison and Dick Hollis, both of whom have exceeded 230ft.

Although the featured 880 wound up as a disappointment to the fans, who expected sensational time, Trojan followers were elated. A slow pace by Oxy's Ty Hadley ruined the clocking and then Tom Anderson and

Wayne Lemons beat him in the kick. The time was 1:54.4.

Hadley, who ran 1:49.8 last week, was ahead at the furlong posts but the watches read only 29.1, 58.8 and 1:27.4. Lemons pulled up even several times but Ty held him off. Hadley cut loose with a mighty spurt around the final curve but couldn't shake the Trojans. Lemons came abreast as they hit the stretch and both went wide. That gave Anderson an opening on the inside and he drove through in the final 10 yards. Lemons was clocked in 1:54.5, Hadley at 1:54.6.

Oxy absorbed a shock in the early going when Dick

Bronson put the shot 53ft. 6in. to beat favored Glen Johnson's 52ft. 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ in.

Then John Zetzman gave the Tigers a boost when he zoomed past SC's Ted Smith to take the 440 in 47.7.

That set the pattern for the dizzy afternoon of form reversals but the Bengals couldn't keep pace.

Dumas beat Clarence Treat in the highs; Soph Charles Lindsay soared 23ft. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. on his last turn to go ahead of Tiger Rick Schmidt's 23ft. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ in.; Otis Petersens took second in the two-mile over Hal Harkness.

Oxy did take advantage of Troy's vulnerable spot, the sprints, as Rudy Alston and Pete Tunney went 1-2 in a 9.8 century and Alston, Zetzman and Ed Bixler swept the 220. Alston's time was 21.4 around the curve and Zetzman had the same mark.

With Bob Lawson out with his pulled muscle, Oxy cleaned up in the low hurdles. Even this was an upset. Treat, the favorite, finished third to Teammates Mike Logan and Jack Lawrence. Logan did 23.8.

SC won the relay, in 3:14.7, and that was one of the few happenings that didn't wrinkle eyebrows.
