

# Terrific Duels Due in Compton Relays

Seven 15ft. vaulters, including Bob Gutowski and Don Bragg — five 60ft. shot-putters, among them Parry O'Brien and Dallas Long—a broad-jump duel between Joel Wiley and Ernie Shelby — 440 competition involving the likes of Glenn Davis, Eddie Southern, Mike Larrabee, Dave Mills and Chuck Carlson — Max Truex, Laszlo Tabori, Bob Soth and Miles Eisenman record-hunting in the 5,000 meters — prep phenoms Dale Story and Archie San Romani Jr. battling each other in the open mile field.

That's a sample of the show director Herschel Smith has arranged for the 20th annual Compton Invitational cinder carnival Friday night.

## **Entries Announced**

Announcement of entries yesterday at the weekly track writers' luncheon in the Cameo Room bore out predictions that Friday's meet may prove perhaps the best all-around thriller yet presented at Compton.

Only the sprints fall short of top-drawer quality. Roscoe Cook, Bobby Morrow and Ray Norton will not compete, leaving Ralph Alspaugh of Texas or Willie White of California the probable favorite.

Eight 1958 winners will defend their championships — O'Brien, shot; Bob Voiles, javelin; Gutowski, vault; Shelby, broad jump; Charlie Dumas, high jump; Ancel Robinson, high and low hurdles; Southern, 440; White, 100. All but Dumas, however, face mighty rough going.
