TROY, UCLA TIE AS RECORDS FALL

One individual record and four team records fell yesterday forenoon as UCLA and SC broke even in their annual relays meet at Westwood.

Each squad captured six events.

Mike Page of the Trojans set a new meet mark in the javelin with a toss of 223ft. 5in, and be teamed with Doug Rainier and Jack Kuhns to give SC a new three - man high of 557ft. 21%in.

Other Records

SC also bettered former totals in the broad jump and pole vault.

Bill Jackson, Luther Hayes and Charles Lindsay aggregated 69ft. 2½in horizontally, whil'e Jim Brewer, Jim Freudenthal and Ernie Bullard totaled 41ft. 10½in. vertically.

Surprise of the meet was the failure of George Roubanis, the Bruins' great vaulter, to do better than 13ft. 6in, and a fifth-place tie, He has cleared 15ft. 1in. competitively.

UCLA's shot-putting trio of Clark Branson, Duane Milleman and Bill Cleves accounted for a new meet record with their total of 160ft. 10¹/₄in.

Minor injuries and flu pro-

duced numerous scratches, causing cancellation of the two-mile run and junking the anticipated high-jumping duel between Nagalingam Ethirveersingam of the Bruins and Charlie Dumas of the Troians.

Some 3,500 fans took in the sun-bathed activities.
