

Santa Ana's Clark Sets 2-Mile Mark

SANTA ANA, March 13—Sophomore Charles Clark of Santa Ana College eclipsed the national junior collegiate two-mile record by more than 15 seconds with a 9:05.1 time today.

Clark bettered the official 9:20.3 record set in 1958 by Bakersfield's Miles Eisenmann. His closest rival at the tape was more than a half lap behind.

Shot putter Dallas Long and sprinter Bruce Munn led SC Frosh to victories over Santa Ana and Los Angeles Valley in the double dual meet. Long put the shot 60ft. 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. and twirled the discus 155ft. 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. Munn won the 100 and 220 with wind-aided 9.7 and 20.8 times.
