

Troy Nabs 91-40 Win at Arizona

TUCSON, March 14 (UPI)—Southern California scored its 79th consecutive dual track victory today with a 91-40 triumph over Arizona before 2,000 spectators.

The Wildcats managed for the first time to win three events from the national champions. It was the first time the Trojans have scored less than 100 points since the series began in 1953.

Arizona's Ray Hiscock was the only record breaker. The burley junior bettered the meet mark with a shot put of 55ft. 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. SC's Ray Martin set the old record of 55ft. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. in 1956.

The Trojans' Charley Dumas won the high jump, as expected, but with a below-par lead of 6ft. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ in.

Another below-average performance was in the pole vault. Trojan Ernie Bullard won it at 14 ft. Ace vaulter Jim Brewer and three others tied at 13ft. 2in.

Dumas and SC's Bob Staten were only double winners. Dumas won the 120-yd. high hurdles in addition to the broadjump. Staten took the 220-yd. dash and the 220-yd. low hurdles.
