

SC's sensational freshman Bruce Munn blazed to 9.6 and 20.8 clockings in the sprints during yesterday's Trobabe-Mt. San Antonio track meet at Mt. SAC.

Munn's mark in the 220 breaks the SC frosh record of 20.9 set in 1929 by Charley Borah.

Six men were caught under 10 flat in the 100 with the Trojans' Lynn Gaskill

second in 9.7 and Mt. SAC's Jim Rood third in 9.8.

Dallas Long also doubled up in the win column — throwing the shot 60 feet 7½ inches and hurling the discus 155 feet, 4½ inches.

Other good times turned in during the dual meet were Wayne Farlow's (SC) half mile in 1:57.2; Tony Smithers' (SC) two mile of 9:40.1 and Walt Phillips' (Mt. SAC)

high hurdle mark of 15 flat.

The Mountaineers used their superior depth to win the meet, 84½-46½, although SC led in first places, 8-7. The winners:
