

O'Brien, Long Fail to Set World Record

For the first time in history, three shot-putters did 61 ft. or better in the same meet yesterday — but no world record heave was forthcoming.

It happened during the SPAAU Relays at East Los Angeles JC.

Parry O'Brien, who owns the world mark of 63 ft. 2 in., got off the top toss of 62 ft. 5 in., while Dallas Long got 62 ft. $\frac{3}{4}$ in., and Dave Davis 61 even.

O'Brien, competing unattached in the university-open division, made mincemeat of the old meet record — Ray Martin's 56 ft. 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ in. And though mastered by the old master yesterday, young Long enjoyed a large afternoon in his own league.

That 62 ft. $\frac{3}{4}$ in. shattered the nation college freshman record by more than 4 ft. and the meet record for that category by almost 9 ft.!

Wait until this 18-year-old, 260-pound, 6-ft. 4-in. kid grows up.

The former national freshman high was 57 ft. 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ in.,

set in 1957 by Davis when he was a Trojan yearling. And the meet record was 53 ft. 6¼ in., also held by Davis.

Though restricted to frosh competition, Long threw with O'Brien, Davis and the other open division contestants. Because of the heavy entry list, all putters were allowed only four tries. Long fouled twice, boosted the 16-pound ball 61 ft. 6¾ in. and then, on his final chance, 62 ft. ¾ in.

O'Brien Comes Through

The crowd was still cheering that one when O'Brien, whose best previous effort was 61ft. 10½in., stepped up and stole the show with 62ft.

5in. O'Brien then added an exhibition put that traveled 63ft. 1¾in.

Davis' 61-footer, by the way, was the best of his career. Recently declared ineligible at SC, he likewise competed unattached.

Fourteen records fell, and another was established in the hammer throw, a new event.

In addition to O'Brien's shot, university-open marks were bettered by Clarence Treat of Oxy, with 14.3 in the high hurdles; by Rink Babka, ex-Trojan, with 176ft. 8½in. in the discus; by Alvis Andrews of the Striders, with 47ft. 11¼in. in the hop-step-jump; by George Roubanis of UCLA, plus Joe Rose and Don Jeisy of Arizona State, with 14ft. 6½in.

in the pole vault, and by the Arizona State distance medley team, with 9:55.5.

Jeisy, a sophomore, is believed to be the only left-handed vaulter ever to soar that high.

Hal Connolly, Olympic champion and world record holder in the hammer throw, swung the weight 211ft. 3¼in. to give future SPAAU contestants a rough record to shoot at.

Two Jamaicans, twins Mal and Mel Spence, and an Australian, Alex Henderson, teamed with the former Morningside High athlete, Jim McGowan, in shattering the distance medley mark.
